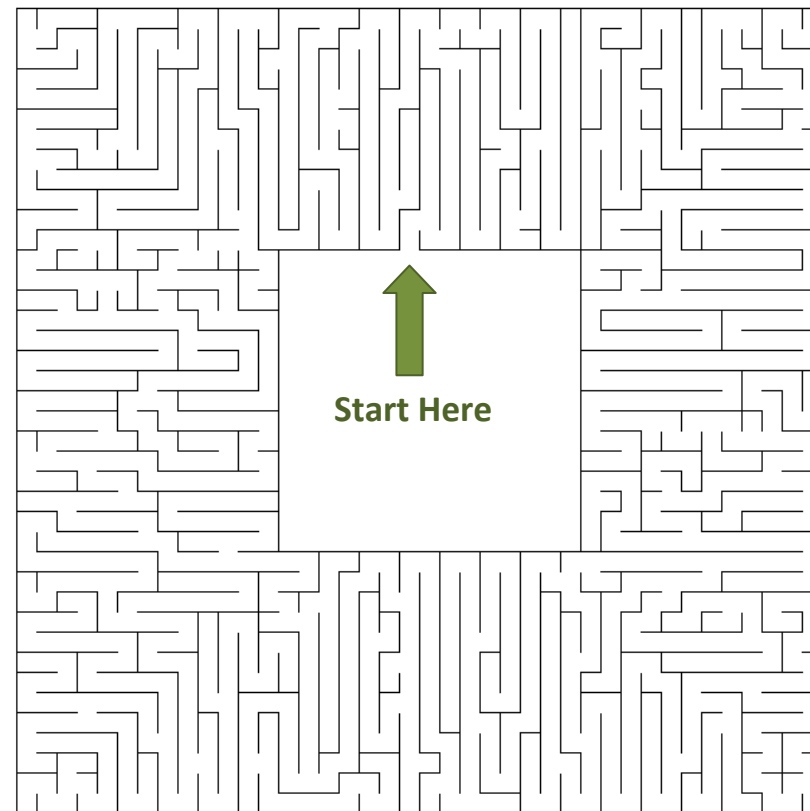

## Iron Chef GPL!\*

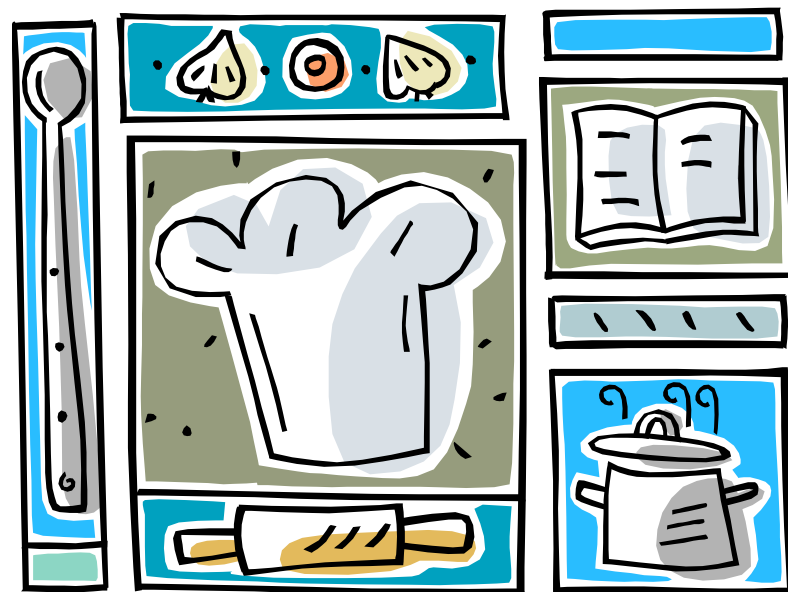

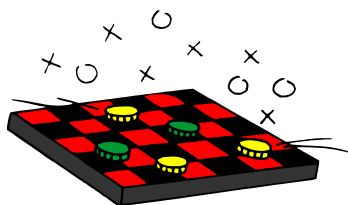
